#### Chronology of Mann Drain violation:

11/04/15- Violation discovered by DEQ/Kalamazoo/WRD (Water Quality) staff. Structures placed in stream and material allegedly for water quality improvement, placed in stream which is also a County Drain.

10/06/16- After-the-Fact application for permit submitted on MiWaters.

11/06/16- Application information request(s) sent.

9/01/17- Application denied after consulting with, and recommendations from Lansing WRD staff.

2/07/18- Contested Case entered by attorney for applicant.

7/18 - 8/18- Negotiations w/ AG staff and applicant's attorney results in agreement for applicant to remove all material from stream; DEQ to conduct subsequent water quality monitoring of Mann Drain and Indian Lake, etc.

8/29/18- All material manually removed from stream under WRD staff oversight, and to DEQ/WRD satisfaction.

Current status- Waiting for confirmation from permit applicant indicating that all removed material, currently dewatering on adjacent property, has been removed from the site and appropriately disposed in a landfill.
