**RESOLUTION 22-01**

**Board of Review Resolution to Allow Residents to Protest in Writing.**

Whereas, In order to ease the burden on taxpayers, the assessor and the board of review and to ensure that all taxpayers have an equal opportunity to be heard by the board of review, the Township of Silver Creek hereby resolves, according to the provisions of MCL211.30 (7) of the General Property Act, that the board of review shall receive letters of protest regarding assessments from resident taxpayers from the first Tuesday in March until it adjourns hearings for which it meets to hear such protests.

Whereas, all notices of assessment change and all advertisements of board of review meetings are to include a statement that resident taxpayers may protest by letter to the board.

At a township board meeting on *February 9, 2022*, *Resolution 22-01* was offered by Clerk Behnke ; seconded by Treasurer Kuriata , and the members of the Township Board voted as follows:
