AMENDMENTS TO CODE OF ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE NO. 021-06

Adopted: October 13, 2021

Effective: November 14, 2021

An ordinance to make amendments to the Silver Creek Township Code of Ordinances to coincide with current state law, to change the designee for fire department invoicing; to remove provisions regarding locations of mobile homes within the township; to repeal any ordinance or provision thereof in conflict herewith; and to set and effective date.

ORDAINS:

SECTION I

**AMENDMENT TO SECTION 152.35 OF THE
SILVER CREEK TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES**

Chapter 152 "Building Codes" Section 15.35 "Electrical Inspection Code" of the Silver Creek Township Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read:

"Pursuant to PA 230 of 1972, as amended, Silver Creek Township is the administering and enforcing agency of the State Construction Code, including the current state-designated electrical code as promulgated from time to time by the State Construction Codes Bureau".

SECTION II

**AMENDMENT TO CHARTER 150, SECTION 150.004 OF THE
SILVER CREEK TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES**

Chapter 150 "Mobile Homes" section 150.04 "Location" is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

“150.03 Reserved for future expansion”.

SECTION III

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 33.19 OF THE SILVER CREEK TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES

Chapter 33 “Emergency Services” Section 33 “Fire and Emergency Services Fee” section 33.19 is hereby amended to read:

“33.19 Billing Procedures.

Following the conclusion of the emergency incident, the Indian Lake Volunteer Fire Department Chief or the Sister Lakes Volunteer Fire Department Chief (hereinafter collectively referred to as “Township Fire Chief”) shall submit a detailed listing of all known expenses to the Township Treasurer or his/her designee, who prepare an invoice to the responsible party(ies). Said invoice shall demand full payment within 45 days of the receipt of the bill. Any additional expenses that become known to the Township Fire Chief following the transmittal of the bill to the responsible parties shall be billed in the same manner on a subsequent bill to the responsible party(ies). For any amounts due that remain unpaid after 45 days, the township shall impose a late charge of 1% per month or fraction thereof.”

SECTION IV

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 33.04 OF THE SILVER CREEK TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES

Chapter 33 “Emergency Services” Section 33 “Hazardous Materials Cost Recovery Regulations” Section 33.04 is hereby amended to read:

“33.04 Billing Procedures.

Following the conclusion of the hazardous materials incident, the Indian Lake Volunteer Fire Department Chief or the Sister Lakes Volunteer Fire Department Chief (hereinafter collectively referred to as “Township Fire Chief”) shall submit a detailed listing of all known expenses to the Township Treasurer or his/her designee, who shall prepare an invoice to the responsible party(ies). Said invoice shall demand full payment within 45 days of the receipt of the bill. Any additional expenses that become known to the Township Fire Chief following the transmittal of the bill to the responsible parties shall be billed in the same manner on a subsequent bill to the responsible party(ies). For any amounts due that remain unpaid after 45 days, the township shall impose a late charge of 1% per month or fraction thereof.”

SECTION V

SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any clause, sentence, word, section or provision is declared void or unenforceable for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any portion of this ordinance other than said part or portion thereof.

SECTION VI

REPEAL AND EFFECTIVE DATE

Conflicting Ordinances and Ordinance Provisions are repealed. This Ordinance shall take effect the day after publication, after adoption.
